



Connecting industry with solution providers

One challenge and four windows of opportunity:



Companies fund their own PoCs / Implementations

Corporates, Mid-caps and SMEs submit their challenges and the Business Creation teams scout according to the individually agreed time-lines

=> Solutions can be implemented in shorter than 6 months



Companies submit their challenges for intl. awards

Corporates, Mid-caps and SMEs may deal their solution implementation publicly (in the BoostUp! BRIDGE competition

=> Solutions can be awarded with up to 30.000€ cofunding



Companies intend to participate in consortia for implementation projects

Challenge owners may apply in EIT Manufacturing's CfPs to look for implementation and application partners in European scale

=> Accepted proposals receive funding from EIT Manufacturing



Challenge owners would need R&D capacities to further develop solution of lower TRL status into commercial prototypes

=> EIT Manufacturing supports building international consortia and respond to Horizon Europe



Pathway towards marketed innovation



Competition EIT Jumpstarter 2023 at EIT RIS

This program aims to support idea-holders to turn their ideas into business with the contribution of best-in-class experts, a creative community, and unique know-how. It provides graduates to validate their project ideas and to build up a business model around it.



- **Type of program:** Competition + Training
- Target group: Individuals with innovative ideas
- Form of support: Training + Prize
- Number of selected projects*: 20
- Financial support*: EUR 3000
- **Prize*:** III. EUR 5000; II. EUR 7500; I. EUR 10 000
- Outcome: Market validated business model
- Application period: April 16

Through this activity in 2020 and 2022, we supported more than 70 teams and 13 startups were created for innovation.

Procedure:

- 1st round submission
- Pre-selection of 20 teams
- Provision Trainings + Mentoring

- Pitch competition
- Selection of 15 teams
- Provision Training in Business Plan (BP) development
- Evaluation of BPs
- Selection of 6 finalists
- Final Awarding Ceremony of 3 winners

What we offer:

- Two open calls per year with a total budget of €10+ million
- Activity durations of 1-2 years
- Call thematics based on community consultation & topical issues e.g., *Smart technologies for circular and green manufacturing*

What we look for:

- Focus on high impact potential and breakthrough innovations (radical, disruptive, transformative)
- That have reached sufficient maturity (TRL >= 6) and need an extra push to be launched in the market (TRL >=8)
- Leveraging a pan-European consortium that includes 2+ end users and technology provider(s)
